## ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Apart from minimum qualification prescribed by the CBSE, the school will consider the following for admission to class XI.

- (i) Excellent academic performance in the All India Secondary School Examination, the Entrance Test and the Pre-Board Examination.
- (ii) Regularity in Attendance in Class IX & X. Those who have less than 80% attendance in class X may not be considered for admission.
- (iii) Character and Conduct of the candidate must be to the full satisfaction.
